



## **OUR HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY**

The safety of our students is of paramount importance at A-Stars Dance and Acrobatic Academy Ltd. It is the responsibility of the nominated parent/guardian to complete the Registration form correctly during enrolment. This is to ensure that the correct next of kin, emergency contact details, medical information is provided. It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to update A-Stars Dance and Acrobatic Academy Ltd if any changes to emergency details change.

- All emergency contact information will be kept electronically by the principle in all lessons.
- A fully qualified first aid trained member of staff will be present at every lesson.
- Parents/guardians must understand that dance is an active sport where injuries can happen, even when safe practice is applied. Students will always be fully supervised during class with the intention to always reduce the risk of injury. All work completed in class is appropriate to each students' ability, experience and physical development.
- All staff will have a Disclosure Barring Service check.
- Students at A-Stars Dance and Acrobatic Academy Ltd. will always be supervised during class. Parents/guardians are responsible for the safety of students in the waiting area.
- Only water is allowed to be consumed during classes.
- In case of a fire, a clear understanding of the correct procedure will be understood by all.
- Premises will all have the appropriate risk assessments carried out accordingly.
- All electronic equipment will be PAT tested and updated accordingly.
- All students are advised to remain within the premises until collected by their nominated parent/guardian or pre-agreed responsible adult.
- Students will never be left at the end of class, a member of staff will always ensure students are collected safely.
